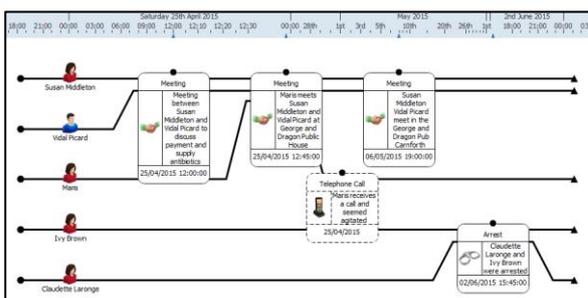
Online - Live virtual classroom training, guided by one of our experienced i2 trainers, and with each delegate accessing a personal virtual machine that contains the necessary software and course files.

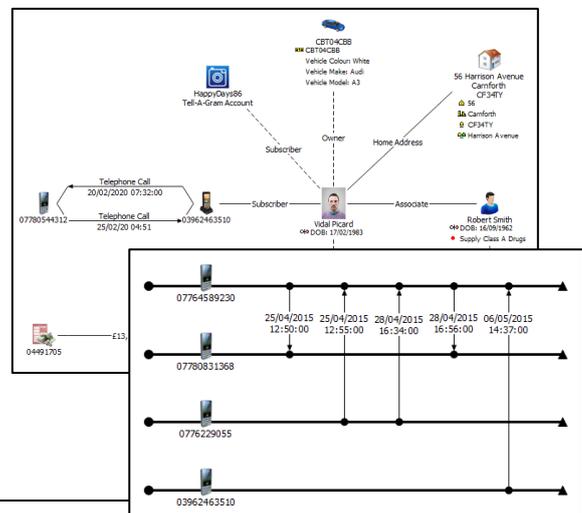

You will use example Intelligence Reports that include:

- Transactions



What skills will I gain?

You will learn how to:

Build and structure Association and Timeline charts to enable understanding of the key concepts of Entities and Links; such as Identity, Date & Time, Description, and Attributes. This will allow the effective creation of charts for interpreting networks, sequences, and accurate analysis. You will also learn to annotate charts by using a Legend and Label, as well as to print them for dissemination.

What can I expect?

Our experienced trainers will provide a tutor-led and supportive training environment using a video conferencing platform – we will make the session friendly and interactive where you can ask questions and talk to the trainer, as well as other delegates. To make sure you have plenty of hands-on experience using the software we will provide each delegate with a virtual machine which will have all the i2 software and course files you will need.

Skills Prerequisites

You must be familiar with Microsoft Windows and opening, closing, and saving files.

Technical Requirements

For the best experience you will need to install the following software:

1. Amazon WorkSpaces Client
2. Zoom Client

It is a simple process, and we will send you all the of relevant links and details on how to do this. Both of these pieces of software need to be installed on the same machine, and tested, before the day of the course.

You can use your own personal computers (laptops, desktops, or iMacs) to attend this training as we provide the training environment which includes the necessary i2 IBM software and course materials. This is an option being used by customers where IT policy prevents them installing the Amazon WorkSpace and Zoom client software on to their work computers.

Is this the right course for you?

This course is aimed at new and self-taught users, or those who want to refresh their knowledge.

It suits those who are required to create charts manually, but not on a day-to-day basis. For users who would wish to use the tool regularly as an analysis tool, we would recommend attending the Analyst's Notebook Standard or using Analyst's Notebook with Cyber & other Digital Data Level 1 courses.
