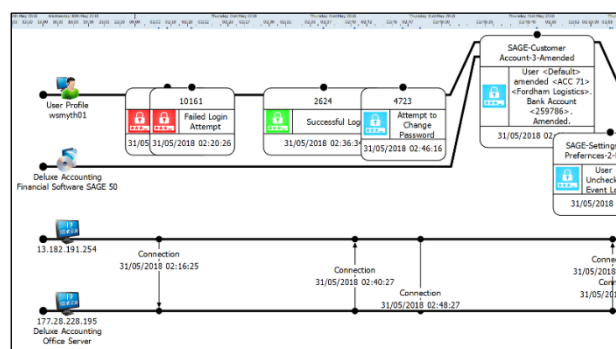

What skills will you gain?

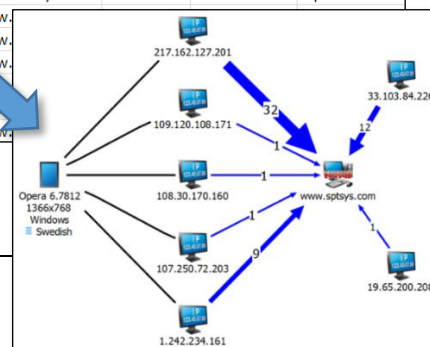
- Visualise digital data into Association and Timeline charts to make them work for you and your organisation

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Objectives

By the end of the course delegates will be able to:

- Create appropriate Analytical and Presentation charts importing data from Microsoft Excel and manually using the training data provided
- Analyse selected charts using the specified analytical tools

Prerequisites

You must have attended an Analyst's Notebook Level 1 – Foundation Course or be an experienced user who understands how to structure a chart.

All courses are conducted in English so you should have a good understanding of spoken and written English. Please note translators can be used on closed courses.
