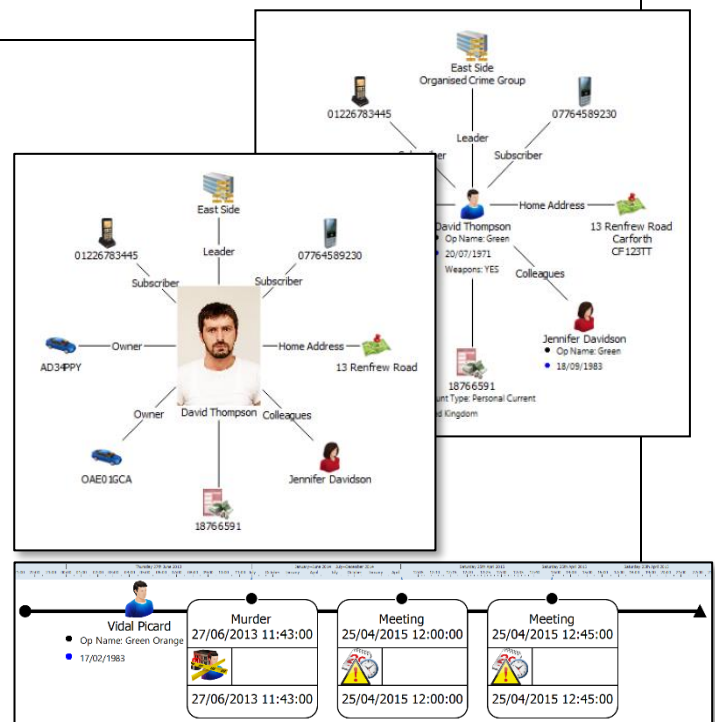
"I can create Analyst's Notebook charts from iBase, but it doesn't look the way I want and there is usually more information on the chart than I can manage."

What skills will you gain?

- Learn how to control the creation of Association, Sequence of Events, and Flow charts in i2 Analyst's Notebook using information held in an iBase database.
- Add the data you need in the way you want for briefing and presentation charts, or for analytical charts that can take full advantage of Analyst's Notebook functions.
- You will also understand how to use the two products together to control what is being edited in either Analyst's Notebook or iBase.
